INFORMED CONSENT AND AGREEMENT TO PAY FOR SCHEDULED OR RENDERED SERVICES: INDIVIDUAL LIFE GUIDANCE SERVICES

The undersigned understands and agrees to *Individual Life Guidance Services* as defined solely as *educational services*. All records and communication will be kept in the strictest confidence allowable by law but may not have the protection of legal privilege that would be afforded if it were a professional psychological clinical or counseling service *which it is not*. The client has the right to discontinue participation any time in this educational guidance service. The life guide educator does have the right to refuse to continue these services at his discretion if difficulties appear to ensue - providing there is a refund for any unused services. In any event there can be no guarantee of any particular outcome beyond the educational guidance provided. There is no offer expressed or implied that the client will be offered or accepted into any concurrent or subsequent clinical service, nor communicate with others providing such services. You must provide notification if you have ever been seen as a client for clinical services by me. It is fully understood that this is not a service covered by third party payers, and such documentation or rules for the release of 'medical' information (e.g. HIPPA) do not apply to these services or to any records kept. Any information request to be provided to any other party must be by written agreement of the client and the life guide, and with prepayment of applicable charges – or not at all.

CLIENT AGREEMENT TO PAY

The client is responsible for payment *in advance* for the initial or follow-up sessions, at the posted rate for the particular module or sessions. ***[Postings in the waiting room for clinical evaluation or treatment services do not apply to these life guidance services.]*** By signing below, you represent that these life guidance services *are not* for any purpose involving legal representation or litigation, whether civil or criminal, and must notify the owner if that changes. Although a good faith effort will be made to take into account true emergent situations, and rebooking of late cancel or missed appointments will be attempted, it is at the discretion of the life guide (the fee for the missed time may be partially or completely forgone.) Checks or other payments that end up not being negotiable or have to be given over for collection may then *also* include *all* related costs and fees *in addition* to the amount originally due.
